

Tourist Visa

Requirement for a Tourist Visa application:

- An application form completely filled-out. (**for non Swedish citizen, please contact the Embassy for information**)
- Passport or travel document (must be valid at least 6 months after the arrival date and must NOT be damaged.)
- Two recent photos in colour or black & white, size 45mm x 35mm with white background.(taken within the past 6 months)
- Copy of your flight ticket or booking paper showing date of arrival to and date of departure from Thailand. In case of applying for Tourist visa for double entry or triple entry, ticket or booking paper must also show arrival date to Thailand for 2nd and 3rd entry as well.
- Fee 200 SEK for single entry, 400 SEK for double entry and 600 SEK for triple entry, *Fee paid in cash when submitting application (Visa fee from 25 June 2009 to 4 March 2010 will be exempted)*

Note: The Embassy does not provide copying service. All the supporting documents must be issued within the past 3 months. The Embassy reserves the right to keep some documents as reference after processing your visa application.

How to use visa

1. **Single Entry** (One entry) The visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 90 days from the date of issue. **With single entry you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry into Thailand.**

Please do not apply for a visa earlier than 3 months before your expected date of arrival to Thailand for single entry.

2. **Double Entry** (Two entries) The visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 180 days from the date of issue. **With double entries, you can enter Thailand 2 times within 180 days and each time you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry.**

Please note that you are not allowed to stay in Thailand 120 days in a row otherwise you must pay for over stay fees.

3. **Triple Entry** (Three entries) The visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 180 days from the date of issue. **With triple entries, you can enter Thailand 3 times within 180 days and each time you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry.**

Please note that you are not allowed to stay in Thailand 180 days in a row otherwise you must pay for over stay fees.

**Attention : Application in person or by a representative at the Royal Thai Embassy.
The Embassy does not accept nor return visa application by post.**

Process-time : High Season (September to February) at least 3 working days.
Low Season (March to August) at least 1 working day (not the same day)

Remarks

- ❖ The Embassy will not process a visa application if the application form is not completely filled-out.
- ❖ The Embassy reserves the right to request more documents or ask for an interview.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the visa application fee paid if your application has been declined.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the documents that you have submitted.
- ❖ After collecting the passport with issued visa, the applicant should check the visa carefully to make sure it accords with your purposes and supposed visit to Thailand. If there are any doubts, you must raise it immediately with the staff. Otherwise the applicants will take all the consequences by themselves.
