

Tourist Visa for the certain Countries

If you are a citizen of Algeria, Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, Cuba, Egypt, India, Iran, North Korea, Lebanon, Libia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Palestine, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Vietnam, or Yemen, the following documents are required to apply for Tourist visa:

1. Three application forms completely filled-out (No copy)
2. Passport or travel document, with 3 copies. (must be valid at least 6 months after the arrival date and must not be damaged)
3. Three recent photos in colour or black & white, size 45mm* 35mm with white background (taken within the past 6 months) Fee 200 SEK (in cash only)
4. Reservation of the flight ticket, with 3 copies (*Please do not buy your ticket until you get your visa*)
5. Hotel reservation, with 3 copies (showing your name, date of check in-out and full address of the hotel)
6. Original Employment certificate in English, with 3 copies (showing that your income is at least 2,000 SEK)
Or bank statement, with 3 copies showing deposit account with balance of at least 2,000 SEK (Document issued within the past 3 months)
7. Original Extract of the population registration, with 3 copies
(Personbevis from skatteverket in English)
8. Fee 200 sek per person (**Fee paid in cash when submitting application**)

Note: The Embassy does not provide copying service. All the supporting documents must be issued within the past 3 months. The Embassy reserves the right to keep some documents as reference after processing your visa application.

How to use visa

Single Entry (One entry) The visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 90 days from the date of issue.

With single entry you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry into Thailand. Please do not apply for a visa earlier than 3 months before your expected date of arrival in Thailand for single entry.

To extend the period of your stay, please contact the Thai Immigration Bureau www.immigration.go.th

Attention : Application in person only at the Royal Thai Embassy. The Embassy does not accept nor return visa application by post.

Process-time : **High Season** (September to February) at least 5 working days.
 Low Season (March to August) at least 3 working day.

Remarks

- ❖ The Embassy will not process a visa application if the application is not complete.
- ❖ The Embassy reserves the right to request more documents or ask for an interview.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the visa fee paid if your application has been declined.

- ❖ After collecting the passport with issued visa, the applicant should check the visa carefully to make sure it accords with your purposes and supposed visit to Thailand. If there are any doubts, you must raise it immediately with the staff. Otherwise the applicants will take all the consequences by themselves.
