

Transit Visa

Requirement for a Transit Visa application

1. An application form completely filled-out.
(for non Swedish citizen, please contact the embassy for information)
2. Passport or travel document (must be valid at least 6 months before the arrival date and must NOT be damaged.)
3. Two recent photos in colour or black & white, size 45mm* 35mm with white background.(taken within the past 6 months)
4. Fee 210 SEK per person (in cash) (*Fee paid in cash when submitting application*)
5. Evidence of adequate finance (20,000 THB per person or 40,000 THB per family)
6. Copy of your confirm ticket paid in full (The Embassy does not provide copying service)
7. Copy of a confirmed ticket for onward destination paid in full. Original ticket must be shown to the officer at the port of entry
8. Copy of visa of a third country in a passport or travel document

Transit visa issued for 30 days with no extension. Applicants are not permitted to engage in any occupation or employment.

Please do not apply for a visa earlier than 3 months before your expected date of arrival to Thailand for single entry.

Holders of Swedish, Norwegian and Finnish passport do not need to apply for a transit visa since you can enter Thailand for a maximum of 30 days without visa

Passenger who wishes to travel to the third country with a stop at the Thai airport under 12 hours without leaving the immigration area does not require a visa. Full paid ticket indicating departure time must be shown at the port of entry.

Process-time : Application in person or by a representative at the Royal Thai Embassy
High Season (from September to end of February), 3 working days.
Low Season (from March to end of August), 1 working day.

Attention: Visa application by post will be discontinued effective from 1st October 2008

Remarks

- ❖ The Embassy will not process a visa application if the application form is not completely filled-out.
- ❖ The Embassy reserves the right to request more documents or ask for an interview if necessary.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the visa fee paid if your application has been declined.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the documents that you have submitted.
- ❖ After collecting the passport with issued visa, the applicant should check the visa carefully to make sure it accords with your purposes and supposed visit to Thailand. If there are any doubts, you must raise it immediately with the staff. Otherwise the applicants will take all the consequences by themselves. August 2010
