

Tourist Visa

Requirement for a Tourist Visa application:

Please do not apply visa earlier than 3 months of your expected arrival date to thailand!

1. **An application form**, completely filled-out.
(for non Swedish citizen, please contact the Embassy for information)
2. **Signature your application.** OBS: please sign on two spots on the application form
3. **Passport** or travel document, valid at least 6 months after the arrival date and must not be damage
(OBS: The Embassy reserves the right to refused your visa application if passport is damage)
4. **Two photos**, size 45 x 35mm with white background in colour or black & white taken not older than 6 months (The Embassy are not accepted a homemade photo)
5. **Copy of flight ticket** (t/r) or bookingreservation flight ticket, must show clearing date of arrival and departure from Thailand.
 - Incase of applying for double entries or triple entries, you must present a ticket or reservation papper showing arrival date to Thailand for 2nd and 3rd entries as well.
6. **Fee paid in cash when submitting application.**
Fee : 260 SEK single entry, 520 SEK double entries, 780 SEK triple entries.
(Visa fee from 11 May 2010 to 31 March 2011 will be exempted)

Note: The Embassy does not provide copying or printing service. Please always bring your own copies. All the supporting documents must be issued within the past 3 months. The Embassy reserves the right to keep some documents as reference after processing your visa application.

How to use visa

1. **Single Entry** the visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 90 days from the date of issued. **you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry into Thailand.**
2. **Double Entries** the visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 180 days from the date of issued. **You can enter Thailand 2 times within 180 days and each time you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry.**
3. **Triple Entries** the visa holders must use the visa to enter Thailand within 180 days from the date of issue. **You can enter Thailand 3 times within 180 days and each time you can stay in Thailand for a maximum of 60 days from the date of entry.**

Please note! - you are not allowed to stay in Thailand 120 days or 180 days in a row otherwise you must pay for over stay fees.
- issued date of visa starting when you leave application for visa to the Embassy!

Attention! Application in person or by a representative at the Royal Thai Embassy. The Embassy does not accept nor return visa application by post.

Process-time: - High Season (September to February) at least 3 working days.
- Low Season (March to August) at least 1 working day (not the same day)

Remarks

- ❖ The Embassy will not process a visa application if the application form is not completely filled-out.
- ❖ The Embassy reserves the right to request more documents or ask for an interview.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the visa application fee paid if your application has been declined.
- ❖ The Embassy will not return the documents that you have submitted.
- ❖ After collecting the passport with issued visa, the applicant should check the visa carefully to make sure it accords with your purposes and supposed visit to Thailand. If there are any doubts, you must raise it immediately with the staff.
Otherwise the applicants will take all the consequences by themselves.
